The annual meeting will be a time of celebration and inspiration for all our churches. We are honored to have Dr. Kevin Ezell, President of the North American Mission Board as our special guest preacher for this evening. The annual meeting itself begins Monday November 11, 6 PM and concludes Tuesday, November 12, 5:30 PM. If you have never attended an annual meeting or haven't been to one in quite a while, I encourage you to be at this year's meeting and see what God is doing across our state and our convention.

The annual Kiwanis Fair in Statesboro is Monday, October 14 – Saturday October 19. Each year ORBA operates a baby changing & nursing mothers comfort station at the fair. This is a great opportunity to share the Gospel and to minister and serve people at the point of their need. Anyone wishing to serve may contact the ORBA office for more details and to sign up to volunteer.

Finally, October is Pastor Appreciation Month. As you consider the many ways you and your church can express your appreciation and gratitude to your pastor, I strongly encourage you not to forget his wife, children and the other staff members that serve with him. While your pastor is "the guy" he relies upon his family and the other ministry staff to serve and lead well. Here are a few ways to say "Thank You":

Financial gifts: No, he doesn't do what he does for money, but when it costs more for you at the store, it costs more for him and his family.

Gift Cards: Some may consider this impersonal, but it frees him up to purchase what he and his family may need.

Invite church members to sign up for a day, and ask them to provide a service, drop off a gift or have a meal delivered for the pastor and his family. This would allow all members of the church to be directly involved in the appreciation efforts.

Be creative: Does his office need an upgrade? Does his car need to be washed? One church I know would provide a clothing stipend each year.

Whatever way you choose to honor your pastor, his family and other staff members, be sure that it doesn't end when the calendar changes. He needs your encouragement every day.
