WHEW!! What a time it has been here at the Mann Center these past few months!! Hurricane Debbie and the flooding and then Hurricane Hellene with her devastating, monstrous winds!! The damage down here was devastating with numerous trees down and several trees on some of our buildings. Duane, my sister, Sandra, and myself spent the better part of a month cleaning up what we could manage. With Duane on the chainsaw, Sandra dragging limbs to the burn pile, and myself manning the truck and trailer hauling firewood to the firewood pile. We were able to cut up 9 trees in firewood lengths, burn all of the limbs, and distribute firewood the those that came to pick it up. We put "a dent" in the damage, but then GOD really blessed us immensely when Mr. Ellis Wood and his son, Matt came down to assess the damage. They brought in some heavy equipment and a crew that came in here on January 24th and began clearing, cutting, and burning debris.
